Applying for the B.Cons. (Hons) course full-time (Overseas students)

1. Applicants are requested to ensure that **TWO** application forms are to be filled in. The undergraduate application form can be downloaded from:

2. **ALL sections of the application form are to be completed by applicant. If any section is left incomplete, the application will be refused.**

3. The following documents/material should be included:

- Two passport size photos;
- certified copies of original educational certificates and transcripts (see Section F). The original certificates have to be produced on arrival in Malta;
- certified English translation of certificates and transcripts, the originals of which are not in English (see Section F);
- English Language Proficiency Certificate (see Section I);
- Birth Certificate;
- photocopy of passport (mainly pages with personal and passport details);
- non-refundable application fee of MTL 40*; bank drafts should be made payable to the **University of Malta**.

(*The application fee for home students and EU nationals will be LM 10, approximately Euros 25. Current rates of exchange can be obtained from:

4. **Section A:** In this section, you are required to indicate the course you intend to follow. Unless the course code and course title are clearly indicated on the application the application will not be considered. Information about course codes and titles may be downloaded from:

As soon as results are published, applicants should immediately submit the grades achieved to the International Office, University of Malta.
